

Adam El Mihdawy Takes out No. 2 Seed in Rimouski

Rimouski, Canada – March 19, 2013

Loriet player Adam El Mihdawy battled through a three-set tie-breaker against ATP World No. 127 Malik Jaziri to win 6-4, 4-6, 7–6 in Canada's Rimouski Challenger. Adam who qualified for the tournament faced M. Jaziri in the first round. Jaziri, a seasoned journeyman, had taken a set from Federer just a month early in Dubai.

Adam started the match strong with an early 3-0 lead but lost his momentum in the middle of the second set. Both players fought hard in the third set, each elevating their game at pivotal moments. After three sets of unexpected gets, impressive shot making, long rallies and 2 match points saved by Adam, the match went into a tiebreaker. In the tiebreak, Adam played aggressively to take the lead and ultimately win the match.
