Niki Coopersmith's Impressive Results Continue

Over the last two months Niki Coopersmith, who practices twice a day Mondays through Fridays and once on Saturday mornings at beautiful Pine Bluff Country Club, where her father is the tennis director, placed third in national singles and doubles, led all Arkansas junior tennis players with a Girl's 12s ranking of 2nd in the Southern Section, and just finished competing in 14s nationals in Rome, Georgia and 14s sectionals in Mobile, Alabama.

Niki has entered to play in the Orange Bowl coming up in December. The Junior Orange Bowl Youth Festival is known as the largest international youth sports and arts festival founded in 1948. The 50th annual Orange Bowl Championships will take place December 14-23 at different locations in Coral Gables and Miami.

In addition to Niki's incredible performances stateside, she will begin practices in Europe this week, training in Jurmala Latvia at [Masters Tennis Academy](#), where her father will be advising the coaching staff. Niki, who turned 12 years old last May, is both a seasoned player and traveler, who's mother was a WTA and Fed Cup player, and whose father is a professional coach with extensive experience working with a wide array of talented players.
